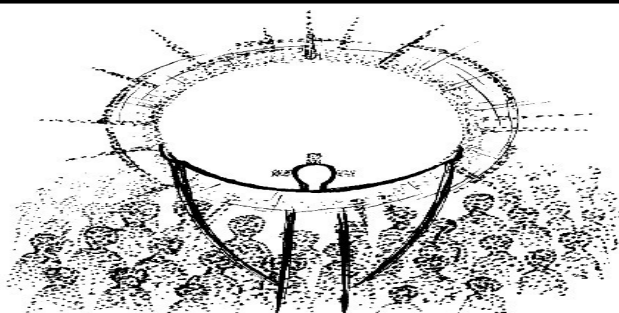
Spiritual Communion:
