Dear Parents and Carers

I hope that you are all safe and well. Thank you again for your patience in these difficult times. It has been a pleasure to welcome back 10 of our Year 6 pupils. They have settled well into school and adapted to the new routines. Our numbers are slowly increasing and we are currently looking at how we can enable more children to access school before the Summer holidays. This week we aim to establish which children will be accessing a school place starting next week under the government guidance. Following this we will be able to decide whether or not we have the capacity to extend the wider opening of school to Year 1.

In the meantime, our aim is to support your child through home learning. We have noticed a significant decline in home learning since half term and we are keen to improve this but will need your help! The work which will be set for the next 4 weeks will be based around the non negotiables for your child's year. Non negotiables are key skills that your child will need to help them with their learning in their next class and will include reading, writing and maths.

Transition:

This weeks objectives are as follows:

Maths

Compare and order numbers to 100 and use <,> and =
Recall and use the multiplication and division facts for 2,5,and 10 x tables
Tell the time to 5 minutes including quarter past/to

Reading

The following objectives can be taught through sharing a story or stories together each day Recount the main theme of stories

Recount the main events in order

Comment on how a text is structured

Writing

Write different kinds of sentences: statements, question, exclamation, command

Use commas in a list

Write lower case letters correctly sized in relation to one another
