FSM Vouchers

Oldham free school meals – are you eligible for a £90.00 per child Free



School Meal voucher over the Summer Holiday? The Coronavirus Pandemic has left many families with different financial situations than before. If your financial situation has changed or you are in receipt of any new benefits you may be entitled to a £90.00 per child voucher for free school meals. Please follow the link below and notify school if you qualify.

Free school meal vouchers are now available over the summer school holidays and you'll need to contact your local school by Friday 10 July 2020 to claim them.

You don't need to make a separate claim for free school meals if you are already in receipt or have applied for Housing Benefit or help with your Council Tax.
