Dear Parents and Y6 children,

We hope you are well in these unusual times.

The Y6 Team have been very busy putting together work for you to complete during the new Lockdown.

Within each pack, you will find:

- A Literacy SATs Information book (pink)
- A Literacy SATs Question book (pink)
- A Numeracy SATs Information book (blue)
- A Numeracy SATs Question Book (blue)
- A class novel
- 2 x exercise books
- A pencil
- A DADWAVERS prompt sheet
- Viking Project prompt questions

Each day, a link will be sent to you to log on to your online learning.

A member of the y6 staff will be providing online Literacy and Numeracy teaching from 9am to 10.30am and pupils are all expected to attend. The lessons will be focusing on the Literacy and Numeracy SATs information books, and children will be told which pages will be taught before each lesson. If children do not attend the online lessons, the input will need to be given by another adult at home, to enable them to complete the related activities afterwards.

After the input has been given, children will then be expected to complete directed activities from the SATs Question Book, which relate to the information given during the online lessons.

These activities should take between 1-2 hours and the SATs Information books can be used as a reminding guide on how to complete the activities.

If children do not engage in the morning learning, you will be contacted by a member of the y6 team to address any issues or problems.

During the afternoon, each child is expected to complete a project about the Vikings. Questions and prompts have been given to pupils to guide their thinking, but children are encouraged to 'think outside the box' too. Projects can be either on paper (exercise books will be supplied) or by Power Point Presentation and they are expected to be at

long (one page to address each question). Children are also encouraged to use pictures, diagrams, tables, charts and lots of text to make their projects informative and enjoyable.

There will be prizes offered for the best efforts. Children will be quizzed on what they have learned in a couple of weeks!

Pupils have also been given a class novel. PLEASE TAKE CARE OF THESE BOOKS as we would like them back after Lockdown. These books are to be enjoyed at your leisure, but we will be checking in regularly to see how much has been read.

Keep the DADWAVERS prompt sheets safe. There will be some writing lessons throughout the online learning which will use these.

Keep your eyes peeled on Seesaw each day for online learning links and for further notes / messages from the Year 6 team.

You had all managed to catch up so wonderfully after the last Lockdown, and we are determined to keep you all showing your best ability, whilst we are not physically there to nag you to work!! So we need your hard work, determination and best efforts to keep up with all of your good work and to shine like the stars you are!
