As lockdown restrictions begin to ease, please take care and continue to follow the government guidance. Please see below for information on what to do should your child test positive for COVID19.

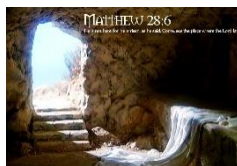

Please remember:

If your child has COVID symptoms:

a cough, high temperature or loss of taste or smell they **MUST** get a PCR COVID test. The Lateral Flow Tests (results in 30 mins) are only for use on people who have no symptoms (asymptomatic).
