**Nurse** – a person who is trained to look after poorly and injured people.

**Soldier** – a person in the army who protects a country's land.

**Modern** – something that is new and is happening right now.

**Victorian** – a time over 100 years ago when Queen Victoria was on the throne.

**Hospital** – a place where poorly and injured people are given medical care.

**Lantern** – a light with sides and a handle so you can carry it.

**War** – when two or more countries fight because they don't agree on something.

**Past** – something that has already happened.
